# SS4A Program

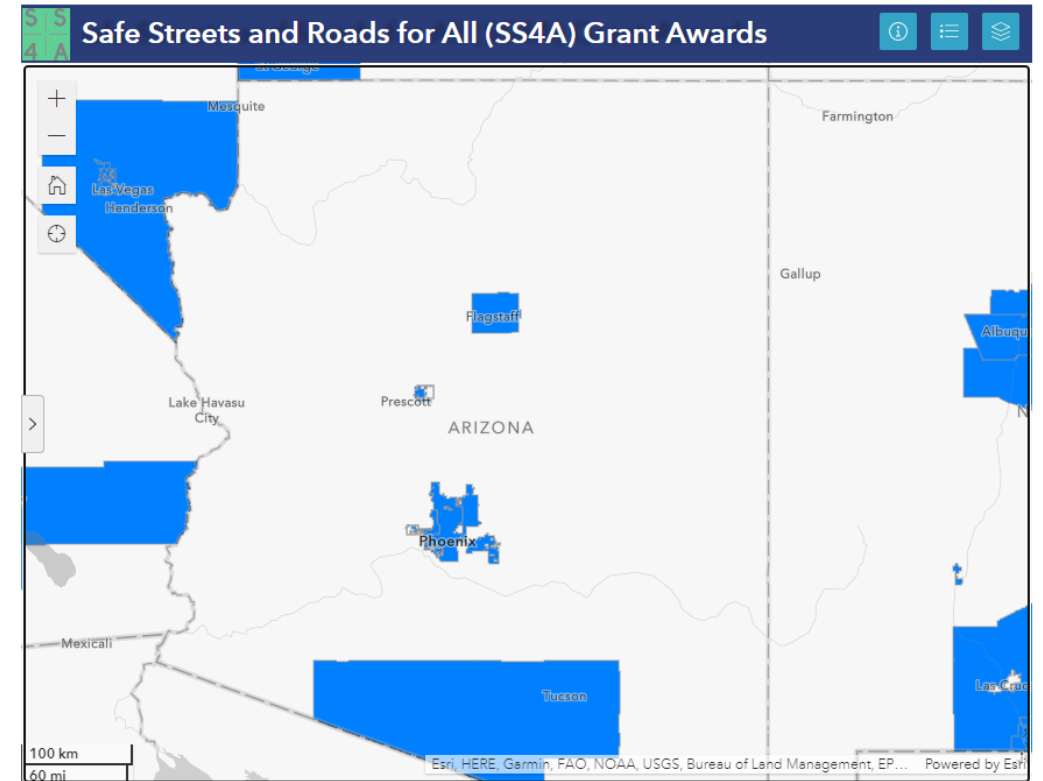
- Part of the federal Bipartisan Infrastructure Law
  - Established a wide range of programs aimed at improving the nation's infrastructure
- Safe Streets and Roads for All Program
  - Focused on improving roadway safety and reducing serious injuries and fatalities to those who walk, bike, roll and travel in a vehicle.
  - \$5 Billion in funding over the next 5 years
  - Two types of grants
    - Action Plan Grants – Planning document
    - Implementation Grants – Implement strategies from an Action Plan



# Mesa Action Plan Submittal

- **August 2022** - Proclamation by Mayor Giles
- **September 2022** - SS4A Submittal
- **February 2023** - Mesa notified that we were awarded an Action Plan Grant
  - Federal Grant Funding - \$750,000
  - City of Mesa Local Match - \$187,500

These awards include [474 Action Plan Grants](#) and [37 Implementation Grants](#), shown in the map below.



# Schedule

- **Summer 2023** – Finalize grant agreement with Federal Highway Administration
- **Fall 2023** – Procure consultant through RFQ process
- **Winter 2023** – Action Plan kick-off
- **Winter 2024** – Completion of Action Plan
- **Spring 2025** – Apply for SS4A Implementation Grant
