Subject: One-Year Term Contract for Replacement and Stock Filter Membrane Panels

for the Water Resources Department (Funded by the Greenfield WRP Joint

Venture) (Sole Source) (Citywide)

Recommendation

Council is requested to approve the award as recommended.

Water Resources and Purchasing recommend awarding the contract to the sole source vendor, Veolia Water Technologies, Inc. dba Kruger Water Technologies, at \$85,000.00, based on estimated usage.

Background / Discussion

This contract will provide replacement and stock filter panels, miscellaneous filter parts and hardware for the Greenfield Water Reclamation Plant (GWRP) Tertiary Disc Filters. It supplies spare filter elements and hardware for the maintenance and upkeep of the Tertiary Filter system required for the normal operation of the filtration system in use at the plant.

Kruger is the manufacturer and engineering design proprietor of the Hydrotech Disc Filter System in use at GWRP. There are no other sources for filters or replacement parts.
