

**RESOLUTION NO. 12221**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE TOWN OF GILBERT, ARIZONA AND THE CITY OF MESA CONCERNING THE PLACEMENT, CONSTRUCTION, AND MAINTENANCE OF A RECLAIMED WATER LINE WITHIN THE TOWN OF GILBERT RIGHT OF WAY

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Approving the Intergovernmental Agreement between the Town of Gilbert, Arizona (“Gilbert”) and the City of Mesa (City), which identifies and defines the responsibilities of Gilbert and the City concerning the placement, construction, and maintenance of a reclaimed water line in Gilbert-owned right of way.

Section 2: That the City Manager, Christopher J. Brady, or his designated representative, is authorized to enter into the agreement, and any related amendments or supplements thereto, on behalf of the City of Mesa, and the City Clerk is authorized and directed to attest to the signature of the City Manager or his authorized designated representative thereon.

Section 3: That the various City officers and employees be and hereby are authorized and directed to perform all acts necessary to give effect to this Resolution.
