Subject: Three-Year Term Contract with Two Years Renewal Options for Streetlight Parts and Materials for the Transportation Department (**Funded by the Local Streets Fund**) (**Citywide**)

Recommendation

Council is requested to approve the award as recommended.

The Transportation Department and Purchasing recommend awarding the contract to the lowest, responsive and responsible bidder, Consolidated Electric Distributors dba Arizona Electric Supply (a Mesa business) at \$124,500 annually with an annual increase allowance of up to 5% or the adjusted Consumer Price Index.

Background / Discussion

The City of Mesa maintains over 42,000 streetlights that facilitate and safeguard vehicular and pedestrian traffic. This contract will provide streetlight parts and materials (e.g., circuit breakers, power distribution blocks, lighting contactors, fuses, wire, photo cells, splicer assemblies, insulators, service wedge clamps, etc.) per bid specifications for the maintenance and repair of City streetlights.
