Attachment A, Annual Service Agreement, Section 1, RPTA's Obligations, Item 1.1 of the Master Agreement is hereby revised to include new subsection 1:

Within 90 days of the close of the fiscal year, RPTA will conduct an annual program reconciliation to determine the actual number of trips or mileage which are billable to each participating city. The reconciliation will occur in all programs, including but not limited to paratransit, ride choice, and fixed route transit services. RPTA will use this analysis to determine which cities have overpaid and which have underpaid based on the service provided. In the event either party owes the other, RPTA will either pay the City of Mesa or invoice the City of Mesa within 30 calendar days of acceptance of the final reconciliation by both parties. The City of Mesa has 30 calendar days to pay any invoices.

Schedule C, Paratransit Services and Financial information is hereby revised to delete the fifth paragraph that spans pages 21 & 22 of the Master Agreement.

The following Schedules amend the Schedules of the Agreement entered into July 1, 2023.

The attached Schedule A replaces and supersedes Schedule A entered into July 1, 2023.

The attached Schedule B replaces and supersedes Schedule B entered into July 1, 2023.

The attached Schedule C replaces and supersedes Schedule C entered into July 1, 2023.

The attached Schedule D replaces and supersedes Schedule D entered into July 1, 2023.

All other terms of the Agreement remain unchanged and in full force and effect.

#### SCHEDULE "B" - CITY FUNDED FIXED ROUTE BUS SERVICE COST ESTIMATE

Locally Funded Fixed Route Bus Service \$4,531,454 (includes FY23 overrun)

The original estimate of \$4,048,060 in the July 1, 2023 amendment needs to be revised by \$224,783 to accommodate the increased costs of the new operations contract. The new total for fixed-route bus service for FY24 is \$4,272,843.

Payments made by the City of Mesa to RPTA for the operation of Bus Routes depicted in Schedule B shall retroactively consist of twelve (12) monthly installments of \$356,070.25 and shall become due within thirty (30) days of receiving an invoice from the RPTA. The adjusted balance can be invoiced upon execution of this amendment.

The remaining \$258,611 is due in a lump sum upon execution of this amendment. This lump sum is an overrun from FY23 which is the result of Valley Metro not invoicing Mesa for May and June.

### **SCHEDULE "D" – RIDE CHOICE**

The City of Mesa agrees to participate and financially support the RideChoice Transportation Services program for Fiscal Year 2023 - 2024. The City of Mesa shall fund an overrun for FY23 in the amount of \$375,902.

The original estimated total gross program cost of \$2,394,791 in the July 1, 2023 amendment needs to be revised by \$176,137 as a result of an increase in the estimated number of RideChoice trips provided. The new total cost for RideChoice Transportation Services program is \$2,570,928, of which City of Mesa's FY24 contribution is \$0.

The City of Mesa will pay the RPTA the remaining \$375,902 in a lump sum upon execution of this amendment.
