Recommendation

Council is requested to approve the purchase as recommended.

The Fleet Services, and Environmental Management and Sustainability Departments, and Purchasing recommend authorizing the purchase from the existing contract with Freightliner of Arizona, LLC for \$390,942.88.

Background / Discussion

This purchase will provide one, low entry, heavy-duty rear-loading refuse truck for the City of Mesa's refuse collection application.

The refuse truck that is being replaced as part of the ongoing City of Mesa vehicle replacement program has met established criteria and will be either traded, auctioned, sold, or deployed to special uses.
