

RESOLUTION NO. 12423

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR DESIGNEE TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY (FEMA) UNDER THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY TO ACCEPT \$1,369,936.63 IN ASSISTANCE TO FIREFIGHTER GRANT FUNDS FOR SWORN CANCER SCREENINGS AND AUTOMATIC CPR DEVICES FOR MESA FIRE AND MEDICAL DEPARTMENT.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The City Council approves the City of Mesa entering into an agreement with the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) under the U.S. Department of Homeland Security, and any related amendments or supplements thereto, accepting \$1,369,936.63 in Assistance to Firefighter Grant funds from FEMA to provide cancer screenings to sworn members and to purchase automatic CPR devices for the Mesa Fire and Medical Department. A condition of accepting the grant is a 10% contribution in the amount of \$136,993.66 from the City of Mesa for these same purposes.

Section 2: The City Manager, or his designee, is authorized on behalf of the City of Mesa to execute the agreement, and any related amendments or supplements thereto, accepting the grant from FEMA.

Section 3: The City Clerk is authorized and directed to attest to the signature of the City Manager, or his designee, on all such documents.
