

## **COUNCIL MINUTES**

September 7, 2023

The City Council of the City of Mesa met in a Study Session in the lower-level meeting room of the Council Chambers, 57 East 1st Street, on September 7, 2023, at 8:12 a.m.

Mayor Giles conducted a roll call.

Mayor Giles excused Councilmember Spillsbury from the entire meeting.

Review and discuss items on the agenda for the September 11, 2023, Regular Council meeting.

All of the items on the agenda were reviewed among Council and staff and the following was noted:

Conflict of interest: Mayor Giles declared a potential conflict of interest on Item 3-a, (Signal Butte Water Treatment Plant Expansion Construction Manager at Risk (CMAR), Guaranteed Maximum Price (GMP) No. 1 (District 6)), on the Regular City Council meeting agenda.

Items removed from the consent agenda: 3-a

In response to a question from Councilmember Freeman regarding Item 3-a, (Signal Butte Water Treatment Plant Expansion Construction Manager at Risk (CMAR), Guaranteed Maximum Price (GMP) No. 1 (District 6)), on the Regular City Council meeting agenda, Water Resource Department Director Chris Hassert provided an overview of the project, stating the plant was commissioned in 2018, is used to treat Central Arizona Project (CAP) water, and has a 24 million gallons per day (MGD) capacity with the intent of doubling the capacity to meet the demand in the area. He noted that financing will be supplied by General Fund revenue bonds.

In response to a question from Vice Mayor Heredia regarding Item 4-c, (Approving and authorizing the City Manager to enter into a Fiber License Agreement with Zayo Group, LLC for the placement of a fiber optic cable network within the public right-of-way. (Citywide)), on the Regular City Council meeting agenda, Assistant to the City Manager Ian Linssen explained the project and provided details about the company and work to be done.

In response to a question from Councilmember Duff regarding Item 5-a, (Resolution declaring the document filed with the City Clerk and entitled "City of Mesa Personnel Rules" effective October 18, 2023, to be a public record and providing availability of the documents for public use and inspection. (Citywide)), on the Regular City Council meeting agenda, Human Resources Director Teri Overbey explained and clarified the proposed changes.
