**Subject:** Purchase of a New Audio Console (Replacement) for the Arts and Culture

Department (Citywide)

### **Purpose and Recommendation**

Council is requested to approve the award as recommended.

The Arts and Culture Department – Mesa Arts Center and Purchasing recommend awarding the contract to the lowest, responsive, and responsible bidder, CTI dba Conference Technologies for \$214,305.29.

## **Background / Discussion**

This purchase will replace the current audio consoles, and accompanying processors and peripherals at the Mesa Arts Center (MAC), Ikeda, and Piper Theaters. This equipment mixes and sends the sound to the speakers for MAC events and is used by performing live groups for their performances.

MAC's current audio consoles are reaching their end of life, repair parts are no longer available, and replacement is due. Replacing the equipment at this time would mitigate an audio console going out or audio issues during a MAC event/show.
