

ORDINANCE NO. 5982

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, ARIZONA, AMENDING MESA CITY CODE TITLE 4, CHAPTER 4 (MESA LIGHTING AND ELECTRICAL CODE). THE AMENDMENTS INCLUDE BUT ARE NOT LIMITED TO: ADOPTING THE 2023 NATIONAL ELECTRICAL CODE; REPEALING IN ITS ENTIRETY MESA CITY CODE SECTION 4-4-2; ADOPTING A NEW SECTION 4-4-2 TITLED “ADOPTED BY REFERENCE” AND A NEW SECTION 4-4-3 TITLED “AMENDMENTS TO THE 2023 NATIONAL ELECTRICAL CODE”; AND RENUMBERING SECTION 4-4-3 TITLED “PENALTY CLAUSE” AS SECTION 4-4-4.

Whereas, the adoption and enforcement of updated editions of fire and building codes promote and protect the health, safety, and general welfare of the public and property within the City.

Whereas, the City Council desires to adopt by reference the 2023 National Electrical Code and to adopt certain amendments to the 2023 National Electrical Code, which shall collectively constitute the Mesa Electrical Code.

Whereas, the 2023 National Electrical Code was made a public record on December 1, 2025, by Resolution No. 12452, of the City of Mesa, and one paper copy and one electronic copy of each are on file and available for public use and inspection at the Office of the City Clerk, 20 E. Main Street, Suite 150, Mesa, Arizona.

Whereas, the City of Mesa’s amendments to the 2023 National Electrical Code, as set forth in that certain document titled “Amendments to the 2023 National Electrical Code,” were made a public record on December 1, 2025, by Resolution No. 12452, of the City of Mesa, and three paper copies of such document are on file and available for public use and inspection at the Office of the City Clerk, 20 E. Main Street, Suite 150, Mesa, Arizona.

Whereas, the existing Penalty Clause of the Mesa Electrical Code, set forth in Mesa City Code Title 4, Chapter 4, is unchanged but renumbered.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Mesa, Arizona, as follows:

Section 1: Mesa City Code Section 4-4-2 titled “National Electrical Code Adopted” is hereby repealed in its entirety and replaced with a new Section 4-4-2 titled “Adopted by Reference” as follows, and the publications listed in the new Section 4-4-2 as follows are hereby adopted by reference and made a part hereof as if fully set forth in this Ordinance:

4-4-2: ADOPTED BY REFERENCE

The following publication, which was made a public record on December 1, 2025, by Resolution No. 12452, of the City of Mesa, Arizona, one paper copy and one electronic copy of which are on file and available for public use and inspection with the City Clerk, is hereby

adopted by reference and made a part hereof as if fully set forth in this Mesa City Code Section 4-4-2:

2023 National Electrical Code

Section 2: Mesa City Code Section 4-4-3 titled “Penalty Clause” is hereby replaced with a new Section 4-3-3 titled “Amendments to the 2023 National Electrical Code” as set forth in that certain document titled “Amendments to the 2023 National Electrical Code” that is hereby adopted by reference and made a part hereof as if fully set forth in this Ordinance.

Section 3: Mesa City Code Section 4-4-3 titled “Penalty Clause” is hereby renumbered to Section 4-4-4 titled “Penalty Clause.” The content of Section 4-4-4 (previously Section 4-4-3) remains the same.

Section 4: Recitals. The recitals above are fully incorporated in Ordinance No. 5982 (this “Ordinance”) by reference, and each recital represents a finding of fact and determination made by the City Council.

Section 5: Preservation of Rights and Duties. This Ordinance does not affect the rights and duties that matured, penalties that were incurred, or proceedings that were begun before the effective date of this Ordinance.

Section 6: Effective Date. The effective date of this Ordinance is 30 days after the adoption of this Ordinance.

Section 7: Severability. If any term, provision, section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this Ordinance or any part of the material adopted herein by reference is for any reason held to be invalid, unenforceable, or unconstitutional by the decision of a court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining provisions of this Ordinance shall remain in effect.

Section 8: Resolutions and Exhibits on File. Resolution No. 12452 adopted on December 1, 2025, and its referenced exhibits are on file and available for public use and inspection at the Office of the City Clerk, 20 E. Main Street, Suite 150, Mesa, Arizona.
