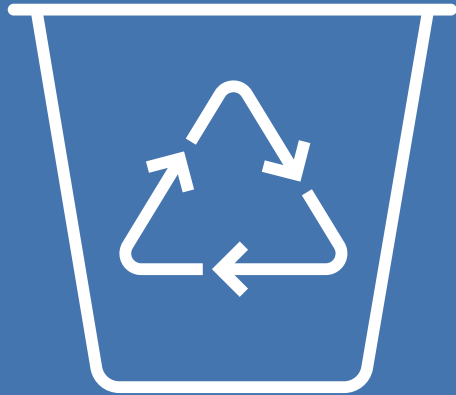

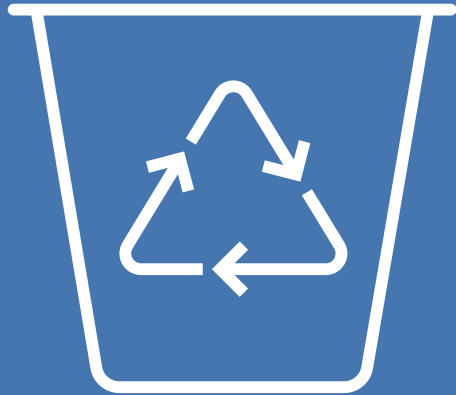

Current State of Recycling

- United Fibers
- 12,500 annual tons max
- Final extension of existing contract ends 12/31/22



Future State of Recycling

- Issued RFP for Recycling with Town of Gilbert in August 2022
- Received 4 Responses
- 2 Vendors Selected

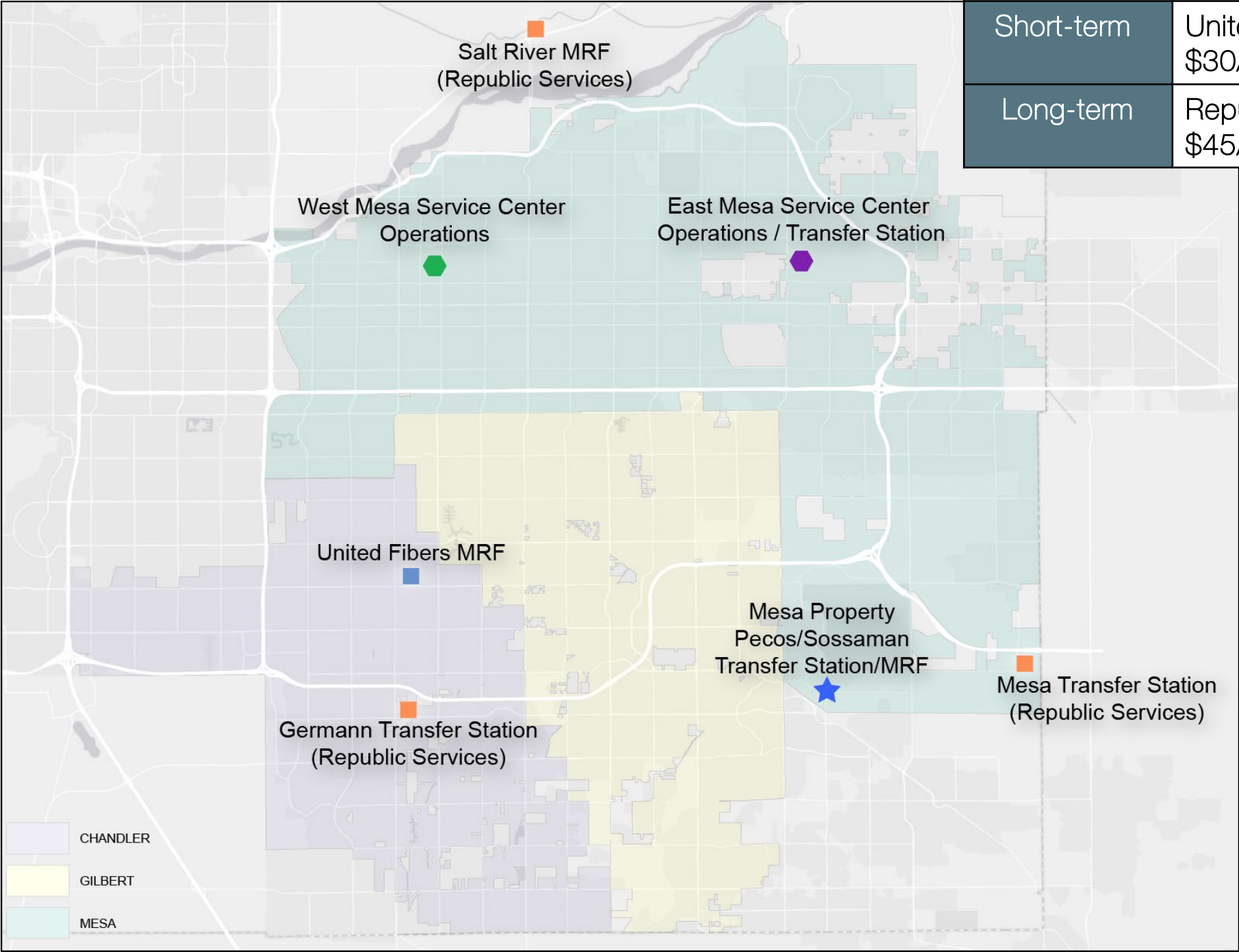
RESULTS

Short Term - United Fibers

- 4 Month Agreement with 1 Month Extensions
- 1,000 tons/month
- 30% Recycled Material Collected

Long Term - Republic Services

- Facility Completion Spring 2023
- 5 Year Initial Agreement with Renewal Options
- 70% Recycled Material Collected



Short-term	United Fibers \$30/ton
Long-term	Republic \$45/ton net



Future State of Recycling

- IGA with Town of Gilbert
- Update to Council in early 2023
- Next Steps: 15% Design

Beverage Bottles, Jugs, and Cans

Empty, Clean, and Dry
Water bottles, milk jugs, soda
cans & bottles, beer cans, wine
bottles, juice bottles, etc.



Metal Food Cans

Empty, Clean, and Dry
canned pet food, vegetables,
fruit, beans, tuna, tomato
sauce, soup, etc.



Corrugated Cardboard

Dry, free of packaging, and broken
down. Corrugated cardboard
contains flat top and bottom layers
with wavy middle layer.



Paper

Office paper, newspaper, mail,
magazines.
Dry, non-shredded paper only.
