**Subject:** Agreement for the Implementation, Maintenance, and Support of a Real-

Time Decision and Operations Management System with the Arizona Department of Administration (ADOA) and the City of Mesa Police

Department (Citywide)

#### **Purpose and Recommendation**

The City of Mesa Police Department is respectfully requesting the Mesa City Council approve and authorize the City Manager or designee to enter into an agreement with The Arizona Department of Administration for the implementation, maintenance, and support of a real-time decision and operations management system.

### **Background**

Funding has been appropriated by the Arizona Department of Administration for a Law Enforcement Records Management System (RMS) to provide implementation, maintenance, and support of an RMS system that will be used by multiple agencies. This platform will create a real-time decision and operations management system which will unify data across multiple sources. This creates a single interface for investigators, analysts, and command staff to securely access, correlate, and act upon data from disparate systems.

#### **Discussion**

Arizona Department of Administration will allocate \$215,800 to the City of Mesa Police Department to provide a program to connect the records management systems and computer aided dispatch systems of multiple agencies. This platform will support Law Enforcement mission needs by providing visualization capabilities and analytics.

#### **Alternatives**

If this agreement is declined, the Police Department will not be able to implement a Law Enforcement records management system to be used by multiple Law Enforcement agencies.

## **Fiscal Impact**

The ADOA will allocate \$215,800 to the City of Mesa and will only be used to implement, maintain, and support a Law Enforcement records management system to be used by multiple agencies.

## **Coordinated With**

The City of Mesa Police Department recommends the approval of the Agreement with the Arizona Department of Administration.
