Subject: Use of a Cooperative Contract for the Purchase of One (1) Pierce Tiller Apparatus (Addition) for the Mesa Fire and Medical Department (**Funded by Apparatus Public Safety Bond Funds**) (**Citywide**)

Purpose and Recommendation

Council is requested to approve the award as recommended.

The Mesa Fire and Medical Department and Procurement Services recommend authorizing the purchase using the Sourcewell cooperative contract with Pierce Manufacturing, Inc./Hughes Fire Equipment at \$2,517,000, based on estimated requirements.

Background / Discussion

The Mesa Fire and Medical Department requires a tiller apparatus to support the mid-rise and turning radius complications being presented in the downtown Mesa area.

The Sourcewell cooperative contract was competitively bid and meets the City of Mesa's procurement requirements. Utilizing the Sourcewell contract allows the City to receive competitive rates based on a formerly solicited agreement. The City believes the price is fair and reasonable and soliciting for this purchase would not result in the City receiving more favorable pricing or terms.
