Subject: Two-Year Term Contract for Itron 400A Gas Meters for the Materials and Supply Warehouse and Energy Resources Department (Addition) (Single Response) **(Citywide)**

Recommendation

Council is requested to approve the award as recommended.

The Business Services and Energy Resources Departments and Procurement Services recommend awarding the contract to the single and responsive bidder, Meter Value & Control at \$1,321,850.02 for Year 1 and \$1,097,807.63 for Year 2, with an annual increase allowance of up to 5% or the adjusted Consumer Price Index.

Background / Discussion

Series 400A Gas Meters are used for residential and light commercial gas accounts. These meters will be used for replacements, to complete the Smart Metering Program, new home meter sets, and future growth. The City has standardized its gas meters to the Itron A Series gas meters. Standardizing the meters helps to simplify the installation and maintenance of the Smart Metering Program solutions currently being installed and will keep the inventory of replacement parts to a minimum, thus reducing costs, and avoiding obsolete parts. The City plans to purchase approximately 4,000 meters in the first year and 3,200 meters in the second year of the contract.
