

RESOLUTION NO. 12270

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR DESIGNEE TO ENTER INTO A THIRD AMENDMENT TO INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT FOR CRIME ANALYSIS BETWEEN CITY OF MESA AND ARIZONA BOARD OF REGENTS FOR AND ON BEHALF OF ARIZONA STATE UNIVERSITY (ASU). ASU WILL CONTINUE TO PROVIDE TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE AND TRAINING ON CRIME ANALYSIS AT A REVISED CUMULATIVE COST NOT TO EXCEED \$597,257.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Authorizing and directing the City Manager, or designee, to enter into a Third Amendment to Intergovernmental Agreement for Crime Analysis and any related amendments or supplements thereto, with the Arizona Board of Regents for and on behalf of Arizona State University (ASU). ASU will continue to provide technical assistance and training on crime analysis at a revised cumulative cost not to exceed \$597,257.

Section 2: Approval by the City Attorney or designee and signature by the City Manager or designee of the Third Amendment to Intergovernmental Agreement for Crime Analysis, and any related amendments or supplements thereto, shall constitute conclusive evidence of this City Council’s approval thereof.
