Subject: Three-Year Term Contract with Two-Year Renewal Options for Video

Surveillance System Maintenance and Installations for the Water Resources

Department (Citywide)

Recommendation

Council is requested to approve the award as recommended.

A committee representing Energy and Water Resources Departments and Procurement Services evaluated responses. The evaluation committee recommends awarding the contract to the highest scored proposal from Goserco, Inc. (a Mesa business) at \$450,000 annually, with an annual increase allowance of up to 5% or the adjusted Consumer Price Index.

Background / Discussion

The contract will provide a qualified vendor to furnish and install Mobotix video security surveillance equipment at sites such as water treatment plants, wastewater reclamation plants, electric substations, well sites, reservoirs and other remote sites. This contract will also provide for a full maintenance contract for the existing Mobotix cameras throughout the City.

Staff issued a Request for Proposal (RFP) to all registered and known Mobotix Video Surveillance System Maintenance and Installation providers. The City received two (2) proposals, both of which met the minimum requirements. Proposals were evaluated by a committee in accordance with the criteria identified in the solicitation. Enterprise Security, Inc. was deemed not susceptible for award and was not considered further. A Best and Final Offer (BAFO) was requested from the remaining respondent and final scoring was completed. Award is being recommended to the highest-scored and most qualified vendor, Goserco, Inc.
