If the approved items have increased in cost since quotes were obtained and CSI funds are insufficient to fund the approved request, there is no obligation or approval to provide any additional funds from the Administrative Office of the Courts (AOC).

Courts may submit a new application for any unfunded items during a later funding cycle. However, there is no guarantee that items not approved in this cycle will be approved for funding in future cycles. It is expected that applications for Court Security Improvement Funds will next be accepted in February 2022. Disbursements for that particular funding cycle will not be made before the end of fiscal year 2022. These dates are subject to change.
