Subject: One-Year Renewal of the Term Contract for Swimming Pool Chemicals for the Parks, Recreation and Commercial Facilities Department
(Citywide)

Purpose and Recommendation

Council is requested to approve the Renewal of the Term Contract for Pool Chemicals as recommended.

Parks, Recreation and Commercial Facilities and Purchasing recommend authorizing a one-year renewal using the City of Chandler cooperative contract with A & M Corson's (a Mesa business) at \$40,000; Brenntag Pacific at \$20,000; and Hill Brothers Chemical Company at \$6,000; for the combined total award of \$66,000 annually, based on estimated requirements.

Background / Discussion

This contract provides four water treatment chemicals (1" Brominating Tablets, Potassium Peroxymonosulfate 45%, Sodium Bisulfate and Soda Bicarbonate) in bulk quantities for the City's aquatic facilities. These chemicals are needed to maintain Mesa's swimming pools to Maricopa County Health Code Standards conform to NSF International Standard 60 and/or appropriate AWWA/ANSI Standards.

City of Chandler cooperatively advertised and bid for public agencies that use water treatment chemicals allowing the participating agencies to take advantage of combined quantity discounts. Participating agencies included Chandler, Mesa, Tempe, Glendale, Queen Creek, Superstition Mountains Community Facilities District, Gilbert, Tolleson Unified High School District, El Mirage, Yuma and Oro Valley. Multiple awards were made to the lowest, responsive and responsible bidders to ensure adequate supply to all participating agencies.

City of Chandler renewed their contract on April 12, 2013. Pricing is competitive due to cumulative high volume purchases and it is unlikely that competitively bidding will produce better pricing. Utilizing the City of Chandler cooperative contract continues to be advantageous to the City of Mesa.

This second, one-year renewal will be valid through 3/14/2014 (total of 3 years) with two, 1-year renewal options remaining subject to future Council consideration.

Alternatives

Council may choose not to authorize the renewal and new bids will be obtained.

Fiscal Impact

The total amount of \$66,000 is available in the Parks, Recreation and Commercial Facilities Department operating budget.
