Subject: Purchase of Fire Monitors for the Mesa Fire and Medical Department (**Sole Source**) (**Citywide**)

Recommendation

Council is requested to approve the award as recommended.

The Mesa Fire and Medical Department and Procurement Services recommend awarding the contract to the sole source vendor, L.N. Curtis & Sons at \$146,000.00, based on estimated requirements.

Background / Discussion

The Mesa Fire and Medical Department will be placing Blitz Fire monitors on the City's pumper trucks. These portable monitors can flow up to 500 GPM either in an attended or unattended mode. These monitors will allow a single firefighter to conduct an effective fire attack and can also be used to assist in ventilating commercial structures. The acquisition of these simple, light and highly maneuverable attack monitors will better equip our department for large Lithium-Ion fires, including electric vehicle fires.
