

## RESOLUTION NO. 12072

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR HIS DESIGNEE TO ENTER INTO AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH MARICOPA COUNTY FOR THE COUNTY TO PROVIDE \$4,000,000 IN CORONAVIRUS STATE AND LOCAL FISCAL RECOVERY FUNDS, TO BE APPLIED TOWARDS THE PURCHASE PRICE OF A HOTEL AT 6733 EAST MAIN STREET, MESA, AZ THAT WILL BE USED TO PROVIDE TEMPORARY EMERGENCY HOUSING AND OTHER PROGRAMS AND SERVICES TO PERSONS WHO ARE EXPERIENCING HOMELESSNESS.

WHEREAS, the American Rescue Plan Act (“ARPA”) established the Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds (“ARPA Funds”), appropriating funds to eligible state, local, territorial, and tribal governments to respond to the public health and economic impacts of the Coronavirus Disease 2019 public health emergency (“COVID-19”).

WHEREAS, Maricopa County received ARPA Funds that can be used in accordance with the requirements of ARPA to provide assistance to communities impacted by COVID-19 and to provide emergency housing assistance and other emergency programs and services for people experiencing homelessness.

WHEREAS, the City wishes to receive ARPA Funds from Maricopa County to allocate towards the purchase of a hotel at 6733 East Main Street, Mesa, AZ where the City will provide emergency temporary housing and low-barrier services for people experiencing homelessness.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The City Council of the City of Mesa approves the receipt and allocation of Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds from Maricopa County and approves of the Intergovernmental Agreement with Maricopa County as presented to City Council that sets forth the terms for the receipt of the funds.

Section 2: The City Manager or his designee is authorized and directed to enter into the Intergovernmental Agreement and any related amendments, modifications, or supplements thereto, including the approval of Administrative Change Orders, on behalf of the City of Mesa, together with all other documents necessary to carry out the provisions of the Agreement, and the City Clerk is authorized and directed to attest to the signature of the City Manager or his designee thereon.
