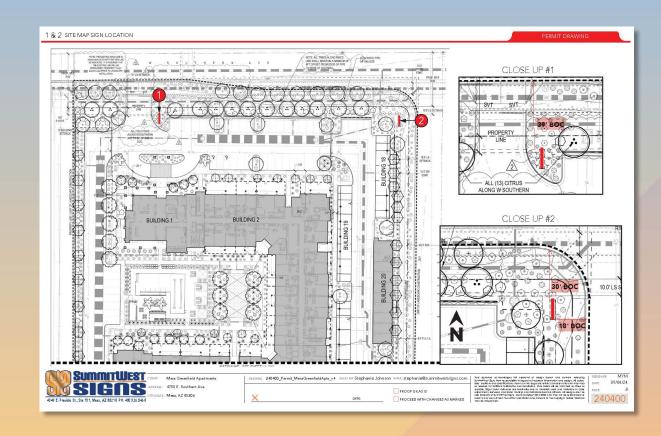

# Sign Plan

- Currently a part of the "Sunny Mesa" CSP which allows for permanent and temporary subdivision signage
- New CSP to allow an illuminated sign that is not adjacent to an arterial or collector street
- No other modifications are requested

# Approval Criteria

#### Section 11-70-5(E) Special Use Required Findings

- ✓ Project will advance the goals and objectives of the General Plan and other City plans and/or policies;
- ✓ Location, size, design, and operating characteristics are consistent with the purposes of the district where it is located and conform with the General Plan and any other applicable City plan or policies;
- ✓ Project will not be injurious or detrimental to the surrounding properties, the neighborhood, or to the general welfare of the City; and
- ✓ Adequate public services, public facilities, and public infrastructure are available.





# Approval Criteria

#### Section 11-46-3(D) CSP Review Criteria

- ✓ The site contains unique or unusual physical conditions that would limit or restrict normal sign visibility.
- ✓ The development exhibits unique characteristics of land use, that
  represent a clear variation from conventional development.
- ✓ The proposed signage incorporates special design features that reinforce
  or are integrated with the building architecture.





# Findings

- ✓ Complies with the 2040 Mesa General Plan
- ✓ Meets required findings and review criteria for Sections 11-70-5(E) and 11-46-3(D) of the MZO

Staff recommend Approval with Conditions
