Subject: Use of a Cooperative Contract for the Purchase of a Camera Surveillance

Solution for the Mesa Police Department (Citywide)

Recommendation

Council is requested to approve the award as recommended.

The Mesa Police Department and Procurement Services recommend authorizing the purchase using the Omnia Partners cooperative contract with Carahsoft Technology Corp at \$457,000, based on estimated requirements.

Background / Discussion

This purchase supports the deployment of a camera surveillance system from Gridless Power, designed to enhance safety at designated parks. The Mesa Police Department conducted field tests of both Gridless Power and Flock Safety solutions, ultimately selecting Gridless Power for its superior performance and value. Their system offers the most comprehensive coverage and integrates seamlessly with the City's existing Genetec platform, ensuring real-time transmission of CCTV footage to the Real Time Crime Center.

The Omnia Partners cooperative contract has been competitively bid and meets the City's procurement requirements. Utilizing the Omnia Partners contract allows the City to receive competitive rates based on a formally solicited agreement. The City believes the pricing is fair and reasonable and soliciting for these products would not result in the City receiving more favorable pricing or terms.
