Subject: Three-Year Term Contract with Two Years of Renewal Options for Gas Masks and Canisters for the Mesa Police Department **(Citywide)**

Recommendation

Council is requested to approve the award as recommended.

The Police Department and Purchasing recommend awarding the contract to the lowest, responsive and responsible bidder, Mallory Safety and Supply at \$290,000 annually, with an annual increase allowance of up to 5% or the adjusted Consumer Price Index.

Background / Discussion

This contract will provide a source for Gas Masks and replacement Canisters for the Mesa Police Department. Officers risk being exposed to many different types of toxic materials. A good quality mask may mean the difference between life and death. Gas masks become less functional with use and element exposure. Canisters have an expiration date which is accelerated by usage.
