Subject: Seven-Month Term Contract with Three Years of Renewal Options for Playground, Splash Pad, Outdoor Fitness and Related Equipment for the Parks, Recreation and Community Facilities Department (**Citywide**)

Recommendation

Council is requested to approve the award as recommended.

The Parks, Recreation and Community Facilities Department (PRCF) and Purchasing recommend authorizing the purchase using the Mohave cooperative contract with Exerplay Inc. at \$150,000 annually, with an annual increase allowance of up to 5%, or the adjusted Consumer Price Index.

Background / Discussion

This contract will provide playground components, equipment and hardware, for the maintenance and repair of existing proprietary playgrounds currently installed in multiple City parks.

Exerplay Inc. has grown to be one of the City's elected playground installer/provider supplying proprietary Landscape Structures Inc. (LSI) playgrounds and other related equipment. PRCF's need to purchase replacement parts from LSI has significantly increased as additional installation of their equipment in City facilities has increased.

The Mohave contract will allow PRCF to meet the maintenance demands of the equipment due to high use volume, normal wear of equipment, and the increasing damage caused by vandalism.
