Subject: 25-Month Use of a Cooperative Contract for the Purchase of Original

Equipment Manufacturer (OEM) Heavy Duty Parts and Repair Services for

the Fleet Services Department (Citywide)

Recommendation

Council is requested to approve the award as recommended.

The Fleet Services Department and Procurement Services recommend authorizing the purchase using the City of Phoenix cooperative contracts with Rush Truck Centers of Arizona; RWC International Ltd.; and Cummins, Inc. dba Cummins Sales & Service at \$2,500,000 annually, with an annual increase allowance of up to 5% or the adjusted Consumer Price Index.

Background / Discussion

The City of Mesa has a fleet of over 200 heavy-duty trucks which Fleet Services maintains. Fleet Services requests to use the City of Phoenix's cooperative contracts for Original Equipment Manufacturer (OEM) Parts and Services to meet the service requirements of the City. These contracts establish heavy-duty truck service labor rates and associated pricing required to complete OEM repairs and purchase OEM parts. The contracts require the vendors to be an authorized manufacturer representative of the services being provided.

The City of Phoenix's contract provides competitive pricing, meets the City of Mesa's procurement requirements, and allows for cooperative use. The contract pricing is fair and reasonable and it is in the City's best interest to purchase from the established contract.
