RE: TMW Offroad, 7453 S. Atwood

Dear Staff,

Please accept this narrative for the proposed development of a Utility Terrain Vehicle fabrication & customization facility located at 7461 S. Atwood, in Mesa., North of Germann Rd, and west of Ellsworth Road.

The existing site is comprised of four lots, all zoned 'L.I., P.A.D.', and located within the Gateway Airport Commerce Park subdivision.

The proposed project is a 30,000 SF, single-story tilt-up concrete panel building to contain a show room, offices, metal fabrication shop, and warehouse.

Additionally, a rear storage yard (east side of site) will be enclosed to support metal fabrication operations, shipping/ receiving functions, and temporary storage of Utility Terrain Vehicles.

Further development shall include all required site landscaping, parking/circulation, refuse collection, and site lighting improvements pertinent to this use.

During review, staff has indicated that a 'BIZ Overlay' be pursued to accommodate two slight departures from zoning standards for the 'LI' zone. These standards, and requested alternate compliance, are itemized as follows:

Compliance with Chapter 21 of the MZO has been achieved through superior quality design by utilizing a compelling variety of building materials, heights, colors, and textures, to articulate a dynamic and visually pleasing statement in the landscape.

The building integrates sweeping metal overhangs in the yard areas, pronounced steel shade canopies at dominant windows and entrances, 'ribbed' steel panels above the two major entry points, parapet height enhancements identifying the two key building corners, and 'relief patterning' in tilt panel concrete walls. Furthermore, shifts in complimentary colors along the building facades create additional layered interest.

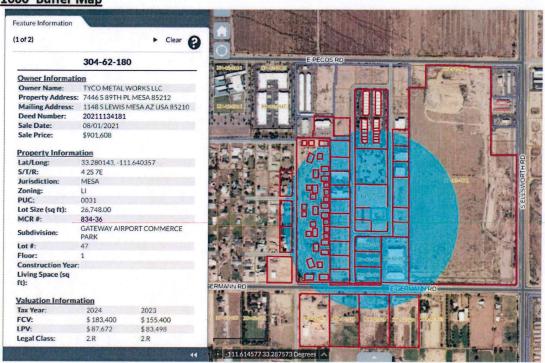
