Recommendation

Council is requested to approve the award as recommended.

The Transportation Department and Purchasing recommend awarding the contract to the lowest, responsive and responsible bidder, Sierra Transportation & Technologies, LLC, at \$70,000 annually, with an annual increase allowance of up to 5%, or the adjusted Producer Price Index.
