Subject: Three-Year Term Contract with Two Years of Renewal Options for Appliances

for the Mesa Fire and Medical Department (Citywide)

Recommendation

Council is requested to approve the award as recommended.

The Mesa Fire and Medical Department and Purchasing recommend awarding the contract to the lowest, responsive and responsible bidder, Mesa Discount, Inc., dba, Mesa TV & Appliance (a Mesa business) at \$75,000 annually, with an annual increase allowance of up to 5%, or the adjusted Consumer Price Index.

Background / Discussion

The Mesa Fire and Medical Department (MFMD) currently has 21 fire stations that are manned by personnel 24-hours a day, seven days a week. Appliances such as dishwashers, refrigerators, stoves, washers, and dryers are furnished for each station. Staff members at each station use these appliances multiple times each day. Additionally, future fire facilities will be furnished using this contract.
