Narrative

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Primary Narrative: E202 responded to house fire that extended from grass burned by home owner on the side of the house in back yard. Upon arrival E202 found light smoke coming from the back yard area. E202 took command and pulled an attack line to the back yard through the side gate. E202 assigned E201 Interior sector for search, rescue and fire control on the interior of the structure. E202 extinguished the fire on the outside of add-on laundry room and then pulled siding to check for extension. E201, Interior, gave a primary all clear report of the structure with no fire on the interior and light haze throughout structure. E202 noticed moderate brown smoke coming from the attic through vents and the gable end. E202 redirected attack line to the east end gable to perform a gable end attack. More hotspots and smoldering was extinguished by E202 while Interior pulled ceiling and checked for extension. Interior also performed salvage and overhaul. Fire was then called under control and loss stopped. E202 and BC252 met with home owners and explained the need to contact their insurance for further actions while assisting them with finding belongings. The home was then left to the homeowners. E202 and rest of responding units went available.
