**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE  
CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA,  
ABANDONING THROUGH EXTINGUISHMENT A 30-  
FOOT PUBLIC UTILITIES AND FACILITIES AND  
INGRESS/EGRESS EASEMENT LOCATED AT 8950  
EAST DECATUR ROAD.**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Arizona Revised Statutes Title 28 §§ 7201-7215 and/or Mesa City Code Title 9, Chapter 10, the City Council has the authority to abandon, vacate or extinguish (collectively, hereafter, “abandon”) unnecessary roadway, right-of-way, or easements to which the City holds right or title to. Additionally, the City generally has the right to release restrictive covenants it holds on real property.

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that a 30-foot public utilities and facilities and ingress/egress easement recorded in Document No. 2008-0652481, records of Maricopa County, Arizona, as hereafter described in Exhibit A (“Public Utilities and Facilities and Ingress/Egress Easement”), is no longer needed.

WHEREAS Mesa City Code 9-10-2 permits the City Council to extinguish easements no longer needed by the City upon application and payment of the application fee.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Public Utilities and Facilities and Ingress/Egress Easement. All rights of the City of Mesa in and to the 30-Foot Public Utilities and Facilities and Ingress/Egress Easement are abandoned and deemed extinguished:
