Subject: Three-Year Term Contract with Two-Year Renewal Options for Commercial

Printing for the Business Services Department (Citywide)

Recommendation

The Business Services Department and Procurement Services recommend awarding the contract to the lowest, responsive, and responsible bidders, United Printing and Mailing; Di-Mor Business Forms, Inc.; the Masters Touch, LLC.; and Courier Graphics Corporation at \$167,000.00 annually, with an annual increase allowance of up to 5% or the adjusted Producer Price Index.

Background / Discussion

Print Services provides essential and cost-effective printing services to all city departments in support of their programs. Print Services will utilize this contract for printing projects they do not have the proper equipment for, or where it is not economically possible for them to complete certain projects. Award is recommended for printing: Group A – Booklets; Group B – Brochures; Group C – Magazines; Group D – Other Customer Printing; and Group E – Envelopes.
