## **RESOLUTION NO. 12292**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, ABANDONING THROUGH EXTINGUISHMENT A TEMPORARY DRAINAGE EASEMENT LOCATED ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF THE 10000 BLOCK OF EAST HAMPTON ROAD.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Arizona Revised Statutes Title 28 §§ 7201-7215 and/or Mesa City Code Title 9, Chapter 10, the City Council has the authority to abandon, vacate or extinguish (collectively, hereafter, "abandon") unnecessary roadway, right-of-way, or easements to which the City holds right or title to. Additionally, the City generally has the right to release restrictive covenants it holds on real property.

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that a temporary drainage easement recorded in document number 2007-1251251, records of Maricopa County, Arizona, located on the south side of the 10000 block of East Hampton Road, as hereafter described in **Exhibit A**, is no longer needed.

WHEREAS Mesa City Code 9-10-2 permits the City Council to extinguish easements no longer needed by the City upon application and payment of the application fee.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>: All rights of the City of Mesa in and to the following described drainage easement are abandoned and deemed extinguished:
