A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF MESA AND MARICOPA COUNTY TO PROVIDE TEMPORARY HOUSING AND SHELTER FOR AT RISK INDIVIDUALS AND FAMILIES DUE TO THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC AT COUNTY LEASED HOTEL ROOMS IN MESA.

WHEREAS, on January 30, 2020, the World Health Organization declared COVID-19 a public health emergency of worldwide concern.

WHEREAS, on March 11, 2020, the Governor of the State of Arizona, Douglas A. Ducey, declared that a State of Emergency exists in Arizona due to the COVID-19 outbreak and determined that the COVID-19 outbreak presents conditions that are, or are likely to be, beyond the control of services, personnel, equipment, and facilities of any single county, city, or town, and which requires the combined efforts of the State of Arizona and its political subdivisions.

WHEREAS, on March 17, 2020, the Mayor of the City of Mesa, John C. Giles, by proclamation declared a State of Emergency for the City of Mesa to protect the health, safety, and welfare of the City and its residents and further declared that COVID-19 outbreak constitutes an immediate threat to life, public health, safety, welfare and economic viability to the City of Mesa and authorized the City of Mesa to take measures to protect the health and safety of its residents, community and employees.

WHEREAS, the City of Mesa and Maricopa County seek to enter into this Intergovernmental Agreement to provide housing and shelter for at risk individuals and families due to the COVID-19 pandemic at County leased hotel rooms in Mesa from July 1, 2020 through July 31, 2020.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the Intergovernmental Agreement between the City of Mesa and Maricopa County is hereby approved.

Section 2: That the City Manager or his designated representative, is authorized and directed to enter into the Intergovernmental Agreement and any related amendments, modifications or supplements thereto, on behalf of the City of Mesa, together with all other documents necessary to carry out the provisions of such agreement, and the City Clerk is authorized and directed to attest to the signature of the City Manager or his authorized designated representative thereon.
