Subject: One-Year Renewal to the Term Contract for Repaired/Rebuilt and New

Landia Recycle Pumps and Mixers for the Water Resources Department

(Sole Source) (Citywide)

Recommendation

Council is requested to approve the contract renewal as recommended.

The Water Resources Department and Purchasing recommend authorizing the renewal with the sole source vendor, Landia, Inc., for \$70,000.00, based on estimated usage.

Background

This contract provides for the purchase of new replacement and repaired/rebuilt Landia AXP-I pumps for the Northwest (NWWRP) and Southeast (SEWRP) Water Reclamation Plants. These pumps are a critical component to the plants and a backup unit is kept on hand in case another pump goes down.

This is sole source equipment that cannot be replaced with other brands unless the entire system is replaced which would not be cost effective.

Landia, Inc. is the sole source equipment manufacturer in the United States for Landia submersible mixers, chopper pumps, recycle pumps and Landia replacement parts and equipment; they have no authorized distributors or authorized service centers.
