LOCATION: Those portions of right of way along U. S. Route 60 taken into the State Transportation System to accommodate construction of the Superstition Freeway, originally designated as State Route 360, being the twenty-one cross streets adjacent thereto beginning with the Dobson Road Traffic Interchange, running Easterly to and including the Ellsworth Road Traffic Interchange, and being portions of Sections 31 through 36, Township 1 North, Range 5 East; Sections 31 through 36, Township 1 North, Range 6 East; and Sections 31 through 34, Township 1 North, Range 7 East of the Gila and Salt River Base and Meridian, Maricopa County, Arizona, as more particularly demarcated on the ADOT Disposal D-C-117 Exhibit "A", attached hereto and made a part hereof.

By signing below, the Mayor and City Council of Mesa, Arizona, hereby waive the Four-Year Advance Notice of Abandonment and Pavement Quality Report, in accordance with the provisions of Arizona Revised Statutes § 28-7209, which will allow the State of Arizona, by and through its Department of Transportation (ADOT) to abandon, according to law, in the near future, all of its interest in and to said rights of way to the City of Mesa for a continued public transportation use, while retaining access control as necessary.
