Subject: Purchase Order for Heavy Duty Truck Brake and Wheel Parts as Requested by the Fleet Services Department (State of Arizona Contract #ADOT11-002926)
"Citywide" Contract

Purpose and Recommendation

Council is requested to approve the Purchase Order for Heavy Duty Truck Brake and Wheel Parts as recommended. State ADOT pricing was evaluated by the Fleet Services Department and the Purchasing Division.

The Purchasing Division recommends utilizing the ADOT cooperative contract with Arizona Brake & Clutch Supply, Inc. at \$50,000, including applicable sales tax.

Background/Discussion

The contract will provide heavy duty truck brake and wheel parts for Fleet Services. These parts are critical for the safe operation of the City's fleet including Fire, Police Department and public utility vehicles. Due to the emergency stand-by nature of these departments, all products ordered, whether new or remanufactured, are required to adhere to the highest industry standards.

Fleet Services has been experiencing severe performance issues with Westpac brake linings. After numerous failed attempts to rectify the problem, the Department has concluded it would be in the City's best interest to discontinue use of the vendor to supply relined heavy-duty brake shoes (Contract #2010163) and procure the necessary brake linings from the State ADOT contract with Arizona Brake & Clutch. This vendor's brake linings have performed satisfactorily to City and industry standards.

The ADOT contract is valid 2/1/2012 through 1/31/2013. This Purchase Order contract will be valid through the same expiration. Additionally, Arizona Clutch & Brake was the second lowest bidder for the original bid. Fleet Services will be issuing a new solicitation for brake parts shortly.

Alternatives

Council may choose not to authorize purchase through the ADOT contract. However, pricing is considered competitive due to the cooperative contract, achieving cost effective and efficient acquisition of quality products and services.

Fiscal Impact

The total amount of \$50,000 is available in the Fleet Services Department budget.
