A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR DESIGNEE TO ENTER INTO A SUBGRANTEE AGREEMENT WITH THE FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY (FEMA) UNDER THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY TO RECEIVE \$492,832.60 IN ASSISTANCE TO FIREFIGHTER GRANT FUNDS FOR SOURCE CAPTURE VEHICLE EXHAUST EXTRACTION SYSTEMS FOR MESA FIRE AND MEDICAL DEPARTMENT FACILITIES.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Approving and authorizing the City Manager, or designee, to enter into a subgrantee agreement with FEMA, and any related amendments or supplements thereto, to accept \$492,832.60 in Assistance to Firefighter Grant funds from the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) under the U.S. Department of Homeland Security, to purchase source capture vehicle exhaust extraction systems for Mesa Fire and Medical Department facilities. The grant requires a 10% contribution from the City of Mesa, in the amount of \$49,283.26.

Section 2: Approval by the City Attorney or designee and signature by the City Manager or designee of the Intergovernmental Agreement, and any related amendments or supplements thereto, shall constitute conclusive evidence of this City Council's approval thereof.
