Subject: Three-Year Term Contract with Two-Year Renewal Options for Chlorine and

Sodium Hypochlorite Chemicals for the Water Resources and Parks,

Recreation, and Community Facilities Departments (Citywide)

Recommendation

Council is requested to approve the award as recommended.

The Water Resources and Parks, Recreation, and Community Facilities Departments, and Procurement Services recommend awarding the contract to the three (3) lowest, responsive, and responsible bidders, Hills Brothers Chemical Company; PVS DX, Inc.; and Thatcher Company of Arizona, Inc.; at \$3,050,349.00, annually with an annual increase allowance of up to 5% or the adjusted Consumer Price Index.

Background / Discussion

Chlorine is a highly effective disinfectant that is used in the water treatment process to kill harmful pathogenic microorganisms such as bacteria, viruses, and parasites at the City's aquatic facilities, splashpads, water and wastewater plants. Chlorine is also fed into the water distribution system at various points to maintain a residual disinfectant value.

Sodium hypochlorite is needed for purifying and disinfecting the water; it also eliminates harmful pathogenic microorganisms such as bacteria, viruses, and parasites. Bulk sodium hypochlorite is employed in the treatment of produced water that meets permit requirements at the City's aquatic facilities, splashpads, and three water reclamation plants.

Primary and secondary awards are being made to ensure the continuity of supply in the event of a supply chain disruption.
