

RESOLUTION NO. 12030

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN TOWN OF QUEEN CREEK, ARIZONA AND THE CITY OF MESA CONCERNING A GAS LINE INSTALLATION – NORTH IRONWOOD DRIVE AND EAST GERMANN ROAD INTERSECTION.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, MARICOPA COUNTY, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Approving the Intergovernmental Agreement between Town of Queen Creek (Town) and the City of Mesa (City), which identifies and defines the responsibilities of the Town and the City concerning a gas line installation at the North Ironwood Drive and East Germann Road Intersection.

Section 2: That the City Manager, Christopher J. Brady, or his designated representative, is authorized to enter into the agreement, and any related amendments or supplements thereto, on behalf of the City, and the City Clerk is authorized and directed to attest to the signature of the City Manager or his authorized designated representative thereon.

Section 3: That the various City officers and employees be and hereby are authorized and directed to perform all acts necessary to give effect to this Resolution.
