**Subject**: Arizona State Treasurer Appropriation for a Pilot Pepper Ball Program

## **Purpose and Recommendation**

The City of Mesa Police Department is respectfully requesting the Mesa City Council approve and authorize the City Manager or his designee to accept \$250,000 from the Arizona State Treasurer and any associated Agreements. Funding will be used for pepper ball equipment, supplies, and training for the Mesa Police Department.

# **Background**

Under Senate Bill 1720, the Arizona State Treasurer has appropriated \$250,000 to the Mesa Police Department as one of three cities to pilot a pepper ball program. The pepper ball program is intended to test a less lethal force option to be used when faced with certain levels of resistance or crowd dispersal scenarios that can be deployed at a distance of greater than twenty-five feet, and that is not intended to cause significant bodily injury.

### **Discussion**

Pepper ball deployment is designed to be a safer option used sooner than other force options, pepper ball is a versatile and useful option. The Police Departments pepper ball policy was approved in May 2023. The units are used within patrol and special operations.

#### **Alternatives**

If this item is not approved, the Mesa Police Department will decline the funds and the State may choose to distribute them to a different agency.

## **Fiscal Impact**

The Department shall purchase equipment, supplies, and training as identified for the program and report to the State as required.

#### **Coordinated With**

The City of Mesa Police Department recommends the acceptance of \$250,000 and any Agreements from the Arizona State Treasurer for this pilot pepper ball program.
