

RESOLUTION NO. 12169

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESA, ARIZONA, AUTHORIZING THE ACQUISITION OF NATURAL GAS PIPELINE TRANSMISSION CAPACITY THROUGH PARTICIPATION IN THE BIDDING PROCESS, AND APPROVING ENTRY OF ASSOCIATED CONTRACTS UPON A SUCCESSFUL BID.

WHEREAS, as the City of Mesa’s natural gas utility service customer count, and therefore demand, continues to grow, additional pipeline capacity on the interstate gas transportation system is needed to continue reliable delivery of gas to Mesa’s system, and

WHEREAS, Kinder Morgan has offered a term sheet for regional natural gas transmission capacity on the interstate system by upgrading the Clausen Gate Station and the opportunity to place bids for the contract and associated regional pipeline transmission capacity.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Mesa, as follows:

Section 1. That the City, acting through the City Manager and his authorized designees in the Energy Resources Department, is hereby authorized to submit bids for regional natural gas transmission capacity at rates calculated subject to the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission, for a term of up to 30 years, and in monthly amounts that total up to 8,000 Dth/day.

Section 2. That the City Manager or his designated representative is authorized to enter and sign the associated contractual documents for capacity on behalf of the City of Mesa in the event of a successful bid.

Section 3. That the various City officers and employees be and hereby are authorized and directed to perform all acts necessary to give effect to this Resolution.
