**Subject:** Use of a Cooperative Contract for a 20-Month Term Contract with Four Years of Renewal Options for Grit Spiral Augers and Related Parts for the Water Resources Department **(Citywide)**

## Recommendation

Council is requested to approve the award as recommended.

The Water Resources Department and Purchasing recommend authorizing the purchase using the City of Chandler cooperative contract with Hennesy Mechanical Sales, LLC at \$150,000 annually, with an annual increase allowance of up to 5% or the adjusted Consumer Price Index.

## Background / Discussion

This contract will provide ongoing replacement parts as needed for the rehabilitation of critical plant infrastructure vital to ongoing Water and Wastewater Plant operations.

The Greenfield Water Reclamation Plant recently experienced a mechanical failure of Grit Auger No. 1. The plant needs to procure a replacement grit spiral auger and support bearings to perform repairs. Hennesy Mechanical Sales, LLC is the state authorized municipal representative for WEMCO Cyclone Separator & Hydro Grit Equipment.

The grit system prevents grit and sand from flowing into the plant causing damage to pumps, centrifuge scrolls and other vital processing equipment.

The City of Chandler cooperative contract has been competitively bid and meets the City's procurement requirements. It is highly unlikely that the City can receive better pricing by issuing a solicitation. This contract is advantageous to the City and is in the City's best interest.
