

Say **NO** to the Rezoning Proposal of 6.1 acres located along
 Power Road at Halifax Drive and Hobart Street
 Maricopa County Assessor parcel numbers:
 218-04-007C, 218-04-005F, 218-04-003C, 218-04-003A
 Titled as Power Road Park, LLC

We the undersigned neighbors hereby declare we are against the City of Mesa Rezoning Case ZON21-00278 for the properties along Power Road at Halifax Drive and Power Road and Hobart Street. Consisting of four parcels within the City of Mesa and within Maricopa County, identified with Maricopa County Assessor parcel numbers: Office Commercial Parcels 218-04-007C & 218-04-005F and RS-35 Parcels 218-04-003A & 218-04-003C. These four parcels are now titled in the name Power Road Park, LLC. The four parcels combined are currently zoned Office Commercial (OC) and Residential Large Lot (RS-35), with Power Food Park, LLC seeking to rezone all four parcels, (approximately six acres) to Neighborhood Commercial (NC). The proposed rezoning is to accommodate the owners of Power Food Park, LLC in expanding its operation from approximately two acres to approximately six acres. We oppose any consideration the City of Mesa is extending to Power Food Park, LLC for the expansion of Power Food Park, which is not a Public Park, but a commercial "For Profit" business. A food truck park is not a reasonable fit to the entrance of this large lot residential neighborhood and does not conform to the Mesa 2040 General Plan in protecting a well-established residential neighborhood. We expect the zoning to remain unchanged at Office Commercial and RS-35 for the above referenced parcels of land.

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
