Subject: Use of a Cooperative Contract for a Thirteen-Month Term with Renewal Options for Emergency Pipeline Repair Services for the Water Resources Department **(Citywide)**

Recommendation

Council is requested to approve the award as recommended.

The Water Resources Department and Purchasing recommend authorizing the purchase using the City of Scottsdale cooperative contract with WACO Contracting; and Achen-Gardner Construction, LLC at \$500,000 annually, with an annual increase allowance of up to 5%, or the adjusted Consumer Price Index.

Background / Discussion

The City's intent is to use the Scottsdale contract to provide for emergency pipeline repair Services until the City can get its own contract in place.

The City of Scottsdale cooperative contract was competitively bid and meets the City's procurement requirements. Using this contract is advantageous to the City and it is in the City's best interest.
