Subject: Use of a Cooperative Contract for a Five-Month Term and Two Years of

Renewal Options for Signage for the Asian District for the Economic

Development Department (District 3)

Recommendation

Council is requested to approve the award as recommended.

The Economic Development Department and Purchasing recommend authorizing the purchase using the City of Peoria cooperative contract with YESCO, LLC at \$100,000 annually, with an annual increase allowance of up to 5% or the adjusted Producer Price Index.

Background / Discussion

Upon completing the Asian District branding and installation of street signs at major arterials, it is important to continue to reinforce the Asian District brand and provide a sense of arrival throughout the district. There is a need for further signage in the district.

Staff compared contracts with the Parks, Recreation and Community Facilities Department (PRCF), City of Peoria, and Mohave Cooperative. Due to the uniqueness of YESCO's turn-key procedures, the illumination of the signs they offer, and previous history with this company at the Mesa Arts Center and Falcon District, staff opted not to solicit a Request for Proposal or seek quotes from other vendors. The City of Peoria cooperative contract was competitively bid and meets the City's procurement requirements.
