**Subject:** Four-Month Contract Extension and Dollar Limit Increase to the Term

Contract for GEA Westfalia Centrifuge Parts and Services for the Water

Resources Department (Sole Source) (Citywide)

#### Recommendation

Council is requested to approve the contract amendment as recommended.

The Water Resources Department and Purchasing recommend extending the contract, and increasing the dollar limit with GEA Mechanical Equipment US, Inc. by \$670,000, from \$450,000 to \$1,120,000.

## **Background / Discussion**

This contract provides GEA Westfalia centrifuge parts, and repair and maintenance services essential to safely operating all GEA Westfalia separator decanters at the Greenfield Water Reclamation Plant and the Northwest Water Reclamation Plant.

The Water Resources Department would like to extend this contract for the next four months and increase the contract amount by \$670,000. This contract extension and increase will allow the department to complete inspections, identified maintenance needs, and work in progress with the vendor, as the City completes working on a new contract.
