Purpose and Recommendation

The Office of Emergency Management has been collaborating with regional partners and Maricopa County Department of Emergency Management (MCDEM) to complete the Hazard Mitigation Plan. The recommendation is to approve the Resolution adopting the 5-year Plan.

Background

Maricopa County Department of Emergency Management has contracted a vendor to facilitate a county wide Hazard Mitigation Plan. Each jurisdiction provided specifics for their community. MFMD Office of Emergency Management assembled a team and facilitated meetings to provide input for a Hazard Mitigation Plan. The Local Planning Team consisted of individuals from MPD, MFMD, Energy & Water Resources, Engineering, Development Services, Information Technology, PIO, and Emergency Management

Discussion

The Plan is reviewed annually and updated at 5-year intervals. The next update will be in 2026.

Alternatives

Taking no action as an alternative will prevent the City of Mesa from being eligible to receive certain federal non-emergency mitigation funds.

Fiscal Impact

Having a current Hazard Mitigation Plan places the City of Mesa in a position to receive disaster assistance funding should Mesa experience a significant natural disaster.
