Subject: Award of Two Additional Vendors and Dollar-Limit Increase to the Three-Year

Term Contract with Two Years of Renewal Options for Ammunition and

Related Products for the Mesa Police Department (Citywide)

Recommendation

Council is requested to approve the award as recommended.

The Police Department and Purchasing recommend awarding the contract to additional responsive and responsible bidders: Proforce Marketing, Inc., and San Diego Police Equipment Co., Inc.; and recommend increasing the dollar limit by \$850,000, from \$2,000,000 to \$2,850,000 annually, based on estimated usage, with an annual increase allowance of up to 5% or the adjusted Producer Price Index.

Background / Discussion

This contract will provide ammunition and less lethal products for various divisions throughout the Police Department.

In December 2021, the City issued a Request for Bid for Ammunition and Less Lethal Products. Mesa had cooperatively solicited this agreement, acting as the lead agency for this contract and included these agencies: Town of Gilbert, Town of Queen Creek, Maricopa County Community Colleges, City of Scottsdale, and the City of Avondale. Due to COVID-19 and supply chain disruptions, the department requested award, and on March 7, 2022, Council awarded all seven, responsive and responsible vendors at \$2,000,000 annually. Contracts were issued to those vendors, however, there were several products on the original bid that did not receive any vendor responses. This bid is a re-release of those no-bid products.

The resolicitation includes duty and training rounds, Force on Force rounds, dummy rounds and blanks.

Through award of this re-solicitation, both responsive and responsible bidders will be added to the contract and the contract amount will increase by \$850,000 annually.
