Fire Department Pension Board – Five-member board including new appointments

## Reappointment:

<u>Kurt Castaneda</u>, Mr. Castaneda was recently re-elected to the Fire Department Pension Board by sworn membership in accordance with guidelines set forth in the Public Safety Personnel Retirement System of the State of Arizona. He has served with the Mesa Fire & Medical Department since 2007 and is currently a Fire Captain. His term will expire June 30, 2026.

Library Advisory Board – Nine-member board including new appointments.
