Subject: Use of a Cooperative Contract for a Four-Year and Two-Month Term Contract for Trash, Recycle, and Compost Barrel Lids for the Environmental Management and Sustainability Department **(Citywide)**

Recommendation

Council is requested to approve the award as recommended.

The Environmental Management and Sustainability Department and Purchasing recommend authorizing the purchase using the Omnia Partners cooperative contract with Rehrig Pacific Company at \$150,000 annually, with an annual increase allowance of up to 5%, or the adjusted Consumer Price Index.

Background / Discussion

This contract will provide 95-gallon barrel lids (Trash – Black, Yard Waste – Green, and Recycling – Blue).

The City currently does not have a contract with Rehrig for replacement barrels. Lids are the most replaced part of a barrel, and it costs much less and is more environmentally friendly to replace the lid than the entire barrel.

The Department believes that going out to bid would require significantly more time and resources, and may not result in cost savings to the City. Omnia Partners offers high-quality and competitive cooperative contracts in public procurement. Rehrig Pacific Company confirmed that both Omnia Partners and Sourcewell cooperative contracts offer the same exact cooperative pricing.
